



# Code of conduct (Policy on behaviour and discipline)

## 1. Respect

1.1. We all have the right to be respected. It is important that every member of the school community feels valued and respected, and that each person is treated fairly and well. We are a caring community, whose values are built on mutual trust and respect for all. This policy aims to promote an environment in which everyone feels happy, safe and secure so that we can live and work together harmoniously.

## 2. Behaviour

The school expects everyone to behave in a considerate way towards others and we use our Golden Rules as the basis for our behaviour.

Our Golden Rules are:

- We are polite, gentle and kind to each other
- We are honest and act with integrity
- We are careful with property
- We respect each other's differences
- We listen to each other
- We respect that others are here to learn

### We like to do the following:

- We treat each other the way we would like to be treated
- We respond when we are asked to do something
- We follow instructions in the event of a fire drill
- We will not run in the corridors or in the classrooms
- We tidy up after ourselves, using the bins provided
- We use nice language
- We attend classes on time and with the right equipment
- We let the school know if we are going to be absent
- We look out for each other by reporting any concerns to a staff member
- We like to be praised for good behaviour and achievement

### We will not accept any of the following:

- damage to property
- bad language
- persistent refusal to accept school rules/discipline
- verbal abuse to staff/pupils or physical aggression towards staff/pupils
- bullying, misconduct, substance abuse or theft
