



Safeguarding

Objective

To contribute to the personal safety of all pupils attending Petite École de Reigate by promoting child protection awareness, good practice and sound procedures in all aspects of safeguarding.

Policy statement

We at Petite École de Reigate believe that pupils have the right to be treated equally and to learn in a safe and friendly environment.

This policy is based on the following principles:

- the welfare of the pupils is paramount;
- all pupils have the right to protection from abuse;
- all staff and volunteers have a duty to safeguard pupils;
- all staff and volunteers have a responsibility to report concerns to the designated persons with responsibility for child protection.

We adhere to our Child Protection Procedures and code of conduct. These procedures are for the use of all staff and volunteers. We can also make them available to the parents and carers of the children. Through them, we will endeavour to ensure that:

- Children and young people are listened to, valued and respected;
- All staff and volunteers are aware of the need to be alerted to the signs of abuse and know what to do with their concerns;
- All staff and volunteers are subject to careful recruitment procedures;
- All child protection concerns should be acted upon immediately. Any concerns that a child might be at risk or is suffering abuse will be reported to our Nominated Safeguarding person.

We will endeavour to keep up to date with local developments relating to the care and protection of children and young people.
